ARRIVAL

- Upon arrival, you and your guests are requested to park in the designated parking areas: the parking lot of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Design (entry via Slėnio St.), or other public parking [lots](#).
- You are invited to attend the celebration with your relatives. The number of guest seats in the hall will be limited. The invitation to the event is for you and two of your guests.





EVENT

- At the location of the event, you will be met by the volunteers who will inform you about the location of your seat. You have to sit in the seats of your group. A detailed seating plan will be published at <https://graduation-ceremony.ktu.edu> a few days before the graduation ceremony.
- The event will begin with the hymn *Gaudeamus Igitur*. Please refrain from applauding after the hymn.
- Volunteers will be stationed near your seats to ensure that each group is invited to the stage on time. The host will then call you to receive your diploma.
- A photographer will capture the moment each graduate receives their diploma during the event.
- The live stream of the Graduation Ceremony will be available on the University's official webpage <http://graduation-ceremony.ktu.edu> on the day of the event.
- After the diploma award ceremony, all participants will be invited to conclude the celebration with an artistic performance, during which everyone will be asked to stand up and throw their caps in the air.
- After the event, graduates can take photographs with their guests and colleagues at the photo-wall in the lobby on the first floor.
- Before or after the event, graduates can have their photos taken at the mobile photo booths and receive their printed photographs immediately.
- Please inform your relatives that they may congratulate you only after the event has concluded.

DRESS CODE

- The dress code of the event is formal. Graduates who do not have gowns and wish to acquire them should contact the Students' Association of their faculty or their elder colleagues.





ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Signing in the diploma registration book will occur during the diploma award ceremony.
- After graduation, a student's IT account **will become inactive the following day**, so we recommend removing all relevant information beforehand. Access to KTU e-resources and the cloud will remain valid **until 30 January 2026**.
- For your convenience, a self-service cloakroom will be available in the first-floor lobby.
- You will be provided with the information about the diploma ceremony photos along with the Diploma Ceremony survey when you receive your diploma.
